### **How To Remove Your Property From NAIS Premises Registration Program**

Ordway, CO (July 31, 2007) - The Colorado Coalition Opposing Mandatory 4-H Premises Registration is offering the following information for landowners who want to remove their property from premises registration under the National Animal Identification System (NAIS).

Send a letter to the Colorado State Veterinarian's Office, 700 Kipling St. Suite 4000, Lakewood, Colorado 80215, providing your premises registration number and request that all information pertaining to you and your property be removed from the NAIS system. Include a telephone number where the landowner can be contacted to confirm receipt of the letter and the content.

Your request will be forwarded by the Colorado State Veterinarian to NAIS for removal from the system.
