Speaker Jim Beers Will Discuss Pinon Canyon

A wildlife biologist that retired from the US Fish & Wildlife Service will speak at the Good Neighbor Forum in La Junta on Saturday the 22nd of September. Jim Beers is a writer, speaker, and consultant to communities being harmed by growing government powers all over the country.

Jim will explain how the Pinyon Canyon issue here in Colorado is similar to Endangered Species assaults on private property and rural communities, and how the upcoming Presidential election magnifies the threats to rural areas like Southeastern Colorado.

He will discuss a new proposal to manage expansion of Department of Defense lands in an open and controllable fashion. This approach should be applicable nationwide and have wide appeal to both urban and rural communities from coast to coast.

The Good Neighbor Forum starts at 9:00 a.m. on September 22, 2007 and will last until 4:30 p.m. Lunch is provided with a \$20 registration fee. This Forum is the second one of its kind held in Colorado in 2007.
